For the 2011 tax payments, Fairfield County had a property reevaluation, and the property values decreased by around 4%. This caused the Fairfield County taxes to decrease, and the tax payments for the residents in Franklin County to increase.							
For the 2012 tax payments, Franklin County had a property reevaluation, and the property values decreased by around 14.74%. This caused the Franklin County taxes to decrease, and the tax payments for the residents in Fairfield County to increase.							
The money that the school district received remained the same, or decreased slightly. This information is listed on the spreadsheet detailing the tax dollars collected for each levy type.
